Road Repair Update.

The township reduced the interest rate for the tax assessment from 5% to 4%. Because the original assessment of the roads was done a while back, the township revised their assessment. Right after the vendor is identified and before the work begins, the board will need to mark all sidewalk panels along Eifert and McCue which will need replacement.
